The study of French, German and Spanish at Harford Christian School takes many forms. Not limited to the traditional classroom, HCS foreign language studies place students in varied experiential situations. Language students conduct weekly classes for elementary children, teaching basic vocabulary and pronunciation skills. French and German programs sponsor summer study trips to Europe for the “total immersion” experience.

Native speakers routinely visit the school for community-related events hosted by students. In addition, foreign language students take part in music and drama activities through concerts and staged productions.

Harford Christian is one of few schools to offer three languages, two taught on four levels. National foreign language exams routinely reveal exceptional competence for HCS students, with scores as high as the 97th and 98th percentile.
